Cleaning & Care

For textile upholstered versions: In case of stains, we generally recommend removing non-greasy stains by carefully dabbing them with a lint-free cloth or sponge wrung out in clean, warm water. Clean by dabbing with soapy water made with a bit of dish soap if necessary. Finally, dab the surface with clean water. We advise visiting Kvadrat.dk, Nevotex.dk, Maharam.com, or Gabriel.dk for further cleaning and maintenance instructions for your chosen textile, as the cleaning methods may vary from one textile to another.

Imitation Leather: Clean with lukewarm PH-neutral, soapy water and a soft cloth or soft brush. Do not use solvents or chemical cleaners, but cleaning can be done with alcohol-based cleaners. Finally, wipe with a damp cloth afterward.

Leather: As a natural material, leather requires looking after. If you care for the leather correctly, it will become even more beautiful over time.

Refine Leather, Easy Leather, and Endure Leather: Regularly clean leather with a dry cloth. Treat the leather at least four times a year using only special leather treatment products. Visit ca-mo.com for further information on cleaning leather.

Allure and Grace Leather: Only vacuum clean with a soft brush. Never use soap or water; otherwise, the velvety look and feel will disappear. Do not apply leather grease or soak the leather. Avoid chemical products, such as saddle soap, leather cleaners, or household products.

Base: Clean with a moist cloth. If necessary, use a little dish soap on the cloth.

Additional Information

The look and feel of the In Situ Modular Sofa is more casual in its appearance, compared to some of our other sofas. The Clay upholstery available for the In Situ Modular Sofa is made in linen, being a soft material that folds and falls more gently over time with less stretch for a casual expression. When the sofa is new, a slight tightness in the upholstery can appear, making for subtle wrinkles in the beginning due to the inherent characteristics of the material. This is perfectly normal and allows for the design to maintain its expression and shape for many years into the future. It will be evened out over time while ensuring that the appearance of the upholstery does not become too loose.







1. SEATING MODULES

Find the seating modules of your desired configuration and add the item numbers of the desired textile or leather upholstery separately to your order. You can only connect modules to the open sides and end of the modules, illustrated here with dotted lines. An In Situ configuration must always have one of the following seating modules at each end: Armrest Module (A8O, B8O, H98 or I98), Ottoman Module (D8O) or Open-Ended Module (F98 or G98).

The Ottoman Module (D8O) can only be used in extension of Open-Ended Modules (F98 or G98) or as the only free-standing I-Seater configuration possible to build.



2. FRAME SECTIONS

Choose the frame section(s) that match the seating modules of the desired configuration (10 frame sections to choose from in total). We recommend using as few frame sections as possible when creating your own configuration for a clean appearance. A Frame Corner Section must always be supported by sections in the two open directions. A configuration with chaise longue modules H98 or I98

must be created using at least 2 sections in total.




3. LINKING BRACKETS

Identify the amount of linking brackets required to connect the modules in your configuration, following the guidelines below. Linking brackets must always be used when joining together frame sections.

Linking brackets must always be mounted on the adjacent sections that face the corner section.





4. CUSHIONS

Specify optional cushions in the desired textile or leather for added comfort and a lounging expression.













